- 120 faith leaders
- 3 cohorts, each meetings for 5-weeks of facilitated conversation and collaboration
- LivingWorks Faith gatekeeper training program



National Guard Incubator Project

- Increase skills of those who may interact with Veterans and Service Members

CSP Sub-recipients

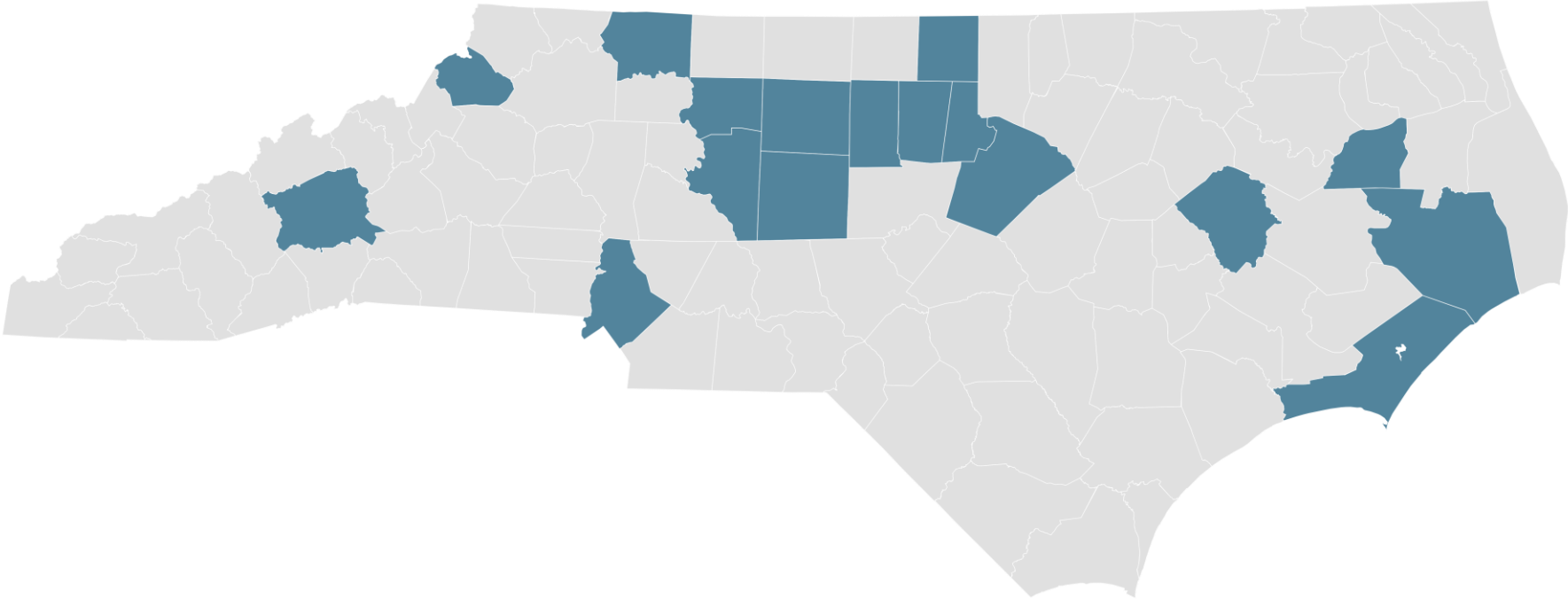
- RFA recipients began work on March 1
- Projects include:
 - Durham County creation of a virtual training for Firearm Safety Team development: projection May 2022
 - Creation of a documentary of the LGBTQ youth experience
 - Plans for specific veteran focus firearm safety team

2022 Injury-Free NC Academy

- **Focus:** schools and youth
- **When:** August 17-18, 2022
- **Applications currently under review**
 - 19 applicants (teams) representing schools, mental health, clergy, human services
 - 13 indicate their community has been impacted by a youth suicide in the last 2 years
 - School district sizes range from fewer than 600 students to over 100,000 students
